SOG# 01-04 – Critical Incident Stress Debriefing	Effective Date: 07/01/2006
Fire Chief: 	Revised Date: 01/31/2013

Purpose: To provide direction for personnel on when to activate a Critical Incident Stress Debriefing.

Scope: This policy applies to all members of the Operations Division

Directions:

1. Personnel safety and mental fitness is paramount and all reasonable measures will be employed to protect department personnel.
2. All responses to any incident where a traumatic stress may have occurred should be evaluated for the need to activate the CISD.
3. If there is a need to activate the CISD then the Battalion Chief or acting Battalion Chief shall notify the EAP to activate the debriefing.
4. The number for the EAP can be found on Staffnet and notification via e-mail shall be sent to Fire Administration.
