Purpose: To provide direction for personnel on when to activate a Critical Incident Stress

Debriefing.

Scope: This policy applies to all members of the Operations Division

Directions:

- 1. Personnel safety and mental fitness is paramount and all reasonable measures will be employed to protect department personnel.
- 2. All responses to any incident where a traumatic stress may have occurred should be evaluated for the need to activate the CISD.
- 3. If there is a need to activate the CISD then the Battalion Chief or acting Battalion Chief shall notify the EAP to activate the debriefing.
- 4. The number for the EAP can be found on Staffnet and notification via e-mail shall be sent to Fire Administration.
